

63.2 The international capacity-building mechanism shall comprise:

a. A capacity-building coordination centre.

The centre's mission will be to stimulate/foster cooperation on capacity building and to enhance and support capacity building. In addition, the centre will assist developing countries in areas of capacity building consistent with their respective capabilities and national circumstances and priorities.

The centre will have the following functions:

- Compilation of information, from relevant sources, including from the Comprehensive review and the outcomes of the Durban Forum on CB
- Analysis of information pertaining to capacity building to identify, inter alia, gaps and needs and other relevant trends.
- Development and dissemination of tools and methodologies for the enhanced delivery of capacity building
- Development of tools for MRV of capacity building
- Matching of identified capacity needs with possible sources of capacity building support from governments, the private sector, intergovernmental organizations, academic institutions, non-governmental organisations
- Close collaboration with other relevant bodies and processes of the Convention, including, but not limited to, the CTCN and the Adaptation Committee.
- Close collaboration with other intergovernmental organisations involved in CB

b. An advisory body of the centre

The advisory body of the centre shall give guidance to the centre on how to prioritize and address requests from developing countries and, in general, shall monitor, assess and evaluate the performance of the centre.

c. A network of regional centres, academic institutions, private and public sector bodies, NGOs.... interested and involved in CC Capacity Building.
